COUNT 1
THEFT OVER \$2,500 BUT UNDER \$10,000

The Grand Jurors for Williamson County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that **DANIEL PAUL LAWSON**, heretofore, to-wit, between January 2015 and August 2017, inclusive, before the finding of this presentment, in said County and State, did unlawfully and knowingly obtain or exercise control over property, to wit: U.S. currency, of a value of at least \$2,500 but less than \$10,000, without the effective consent of the owner, Williamson County Parks and Recreation, and with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated 39-14-103, a class D felony, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 2
OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT

The Grand Jurors for Williamson County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that **DANIEL PAUL LAWSON**, heretofore, to-wit, between January 2015 and August 2017, inclusive, before the finding of this presentment, in said County and State, while designated as an employee or agent of government and with intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, did intentionally or knowingly violate a law, to-wit: theft, relating to the public servant's office or employment, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated 39-16-402, a class E felony, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
