COUNT ONE

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, having been duly summoned, elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire for the body of the County and State aforesaid, present that **CHRISTINA MARLENE MORRIS**, between **November 1, 2018 to March 6, 2019**, before the finding of this indictment in the State and County aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly obtain or exercise control over property, to wit: \$1,000.00 or more in School Cafeteria Collections of **Jefferson County**, without the owner's effective consent, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, in violation of T.C.A. §39-14-103, contrary to the statute, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, having been duly summoned, elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire for the body of the County and State aforesaid, present that **CHRISTINA MARLENE MORRIS**, between **November 1, 2018 to March 6, 2019**, before the finding of this indictment in the State and County aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously and with intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, did knowingly violate a law relating to the public servant's office or employment, in violation of T.C.A. §39-16-402, contrary to the statute, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
