
The Grand Jurors of Houston County Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oaths, do present that between July 01, 2016 through June 30, 2020, in Houston County, Tennessee and prior to the finding of this Indictment, **ROBERT LANCE PARKER** then and there, knowingly and feloniously obtain or exercise control over property, to-wit: approximately fourteen thousand seven hundred thirteen dollars and forty-nine cents (\$14,713.49) in U.S. currency and, a further description to the Grand Jurors aforesaid unknown, over the value of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) but less than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000.00), of Mid-Cumberland Human Resource Agency, without their effective consent, with the intent to deprive said Mid-Cumberland Human Resource Agency, thereof, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, a **Class C Felony**, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO:

And the Grand Jurors, aforesaid, upon their oaths, aforesaid, do further present and say, that between July 01, 2016 through June 30, 2020, and prior to the finding of this Indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, the said **ROBERT LANCE PARKER** then and there, being a public servant with the intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, did unlawfully, feloniously, intentionally or knowingly commit an act relating to the servant's office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power, commit an act under color of office or employment that exceeds the servant's official power, refrains from performing a duty that is imposed by law or that is clearly inherent in the nature of the public servant's office or employment, violates a law relating to the public servant's office or employment or receives any benefit not otherwise authorized by law, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, a **Class E Felony**, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT THREE:

And the Grand Jurors, aforesaid, upon their oaths, aforesaid, do further present and say, that between July 01, 2016 through June 30, 2020, and prior to the finding of this Indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, the said **ROBERT LANCE PARKER** then and there, **ROBERT LANCE PARKER** did unlawfully and knowingly make a false entry in, or false alteration of a government record OR make, present, or use any record, document or thing with the knowledge of its falsity and with intent that it will be taken as a genuine governmental record OR intentionally destroy, conceal, remove or otherwise impair the verity, legibility or availability or a governmental record in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-504, a **Class A Misdemeanor**, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
