



INDICTMENT NO. _____

STATE OF TENNESSEE, COUNTY OF

CRIMINAL COURT

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly summoned, elected impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County aforesaid, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath, present that **WILLIAM LARRY MULLINS AND CAROLYN MULLINS**, between January 1, 2016 and April 30, 2020, in the County and State aforesaid and before the finding of this Indictment, did and knowingly obtain or exercise control over property, to-wit: United States Currency of a value of \$60,000 (Sixty Thousand Dollars) or more but less than \$250,000 (Two-Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars), the property of Peakland Baptist Church without the effective consent of the owner and/or members, and with the intent to deprive it of the property, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
