The Grand Jurors for the CRIMINAL COURT for GREENE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, meeting on July 17, 2023, in GREENEVILLE, after being duly empaneled and sworn, upon their oath present that Misty Spring Taylor, on or about August 14, 2019 through August 5, 2022, in the State and County aforesaid, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully commit the offense of Theft of Property valued over \$10,000, but less than \$60,000, by knowingly taking, or exercising control over, monies belonging to the Sunnyside Volunteer Fire Department, without the owner's effective consent and with the intent to deprive the owner thereof; a Class C felony, in violation of T.C.A. §39-14-103, 105, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.





