Review Highlights

Review of Funds
Administered by District Attorneys General
and
Judicial District Drug Task Forces
First Through Thirty-First Judicial Districts
For the Year Ended June 30, 2007

Scope

Our review included an examination of funds administered by the district attorneys general for the year ended June 30, 2007. In addition, our review included an examination of judicial districts' drug task force funds administered by the task forces' boards of directors for the year ended June 30, 2007.

Results

Eleven judicial districts had findings. We reviewed these findings and recommendations with the district attorneys general and representatives of the Drug Task Forces. Details of these findings, recommendations, and management's responses, as a result of our review, are presented in the Findings, Recommendations, and Financial Section of this report.

The following are summaries of the findings from our review:

FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

◆ The Drug Task Force Fund had a cash shortage of \$1,244 on June 30, 2007. This shortage resulted from the misappropriation of confidential investigative funds by an agent.

TENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

♦ The Drug Task Force Fund had a cash shortage of \$4,520 at June 30, 2005. This shortage resulted from evidence (\$3,200) and confidential investigative funds (\$1,320) being unaccounted. As of the date of this review, the shortage has not been liquidated.

TWELFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

- ♦ The District Attorney General's Office had not adopted written guidelines governing the use of cellular telephones, and the office paid \$2,344 in extra charges related to cellular telephone use during the year.
- Several law enforcement agencies participating in the interlocal agreement did not contribute to the operations of the Drug Task Force (DTF).
- The Board of Directors of the DTF did not assume sufficient oversight responsibility for the task force's operations.

THIRTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

- ◆ The Putnam County Executive's Office did not issue purchase orders for some applicable purchases of the Drug Task Force (DTF).
- The DTF had deficiencies over inventory controls. Officers who were assigned laptop computers had not been required to account for the computers since they had been assigned.
- ◆ Deficiencies were noted in Middle Tennessee Methamphetamine Task Force (MTMTF) expenditures. The Putnam County Executive's Office did not issue purchase orders for several applicable purchases of the MTMTF. Also, competitive bids were not solicited for the design and printing of MTMTF drug education handbooks at a cost of \$55,000 and for the purchase of computers and assessories (\$13,586).
- ◆ Putnam County accounts for transactions of the MTMTF in an agency fund on deposit with the county trustee; however, the MTMTF maintained a checking account for the proceeds from the sale of methamphetamine toolkits. The following deficiencies were noted: (1) the MTMTF did not channel all of its activities through the county trustee's office which violates policies adopted by the MTMTF; (2) transactions related to the sale of the toolkits were not recorded in the accounting records of the Other Agency Fund; and (3) collections from the sale of the toolkits were not deposited to the office bank account within three days of collection as required by Section 5-8-207, Tennessee Code Annotated.
- ♦ An employee of the MTMTF used personal funds totaling \$19,619 to purchase items for the MTMTF.
- ◆ The MTMTF did not monitor a subrecipient of federal grant funds to ensure that the funds were used in accordance with grant guidelines.

FOURTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

◆ The Drug Task Force did not deposit some collections within three days of receipt as required by Section 5-8-207, <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>.

EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

◆ The Drug Task Force used confidential funds to pay some nonconfidential expenditures including clothing allowances (\$2,736) and reimbursements for out-of-town travel (\$2,494).

NINETENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

♦ The Board of Directors of the Drug Task Force did not assume sufficient oversight responsibility for the task force's operations.

TWENTY-FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT

◆ An employee of the District Attorney General's Office falsified travel claims totaling \$3,928.

TWENTY-THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT

• Payments to confidential informants were not witnessed by a second officer.

TWENTY-FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

♦ The Board of Directors of the Drug Task Force did not assume sufficient oversight responsibility for the task force's operations.

THIRTY-FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT

♦ The Drug Task Force did not update its inventory records on a current basis. We noted a vehicle that was not included on the inventory listing.

INTRODUCTION

This is a report of our review of funds administered by District Attorneys General and Judicial District Drug Task Forces for the year ended June 30, 2007, for the first through the thirty-first judicial districts of the State of Tennessee. A separate review was conducted in each of the 31 judicial districts of the funds administered by the District Attorneys General and Judicial District Drug Task Forces. The results of our reviews of the judicial districts are presented in this report.

BACKGROUND

Each judicial district comprises from one to seven counties. Main offices are generally in the county where the district attorney general resides, with branch offices located in other counties. The district attorneys general had funds on deposit with some county trustees of the counties included in the respective judicial districts. The county trustees had one or more of the following types of funds on deposit: District Attorney General, Judicial District Drug, Federal Asset Forfeiture, DUI Task Force, Metro/County Appropriations, Mediation Services Fund, Methamphetamine Task Force, and Other Funds.

District Attorney General Fund

The District Attorney General Fund is used primarily to account for fees received from the Fraud and Economic Crimes Prosecution Act of 1984. In addition, this fund is also used to account for other sources of revenues received by the District Attorneys General, such as: grants, investment income, miscellaneous refunds, contributions, and other local revenues.

Drug Task Force Fund

Some judicial districts have established multi-jurisdictional drug task forces under the leadership of the district attorneys general. These drug task forces were created by contract (mutual aid agreement) between the participating district attorneys general, city and county governments, and approved by their respective legislative bodies. Each judicial district drug task force, which generally includes sheriffs and police chiefs of participating law enforcement agencies within each judicial district, is governed by a board of directors.

Drug task force funds are to be deposited with the county trustee in the county of each district attorney general's residence or another county designated by the district attorney general. The county trustees should credit these funds to the Judicial District Drug Fund.

All nonconfidential financial operations should be expended through these Judicial District Drug funds under the administration of the county mayors/executives. The directors of the drug task forces should submit requisitions to the county mayors/executives for goods and services, which would then be obtained through the county's purchasing system. Cash transactions for confidential funds should be requisitioned and disbursed under the supervision of each drug task force director and chairman.

Federal Asset Forfeiture Fund

In 1984, the United States Department of Justice enacted the Comprehensive Crime Control Act, which gave the Office of U.S. Attorney General the authority to share federally forfeited property with cooperating state and local law enforcement agencies. The three primary goals of the Justice Department's forfeiture program are to punish and deter criminal activity by depriving criminals of property used for or acquired through illegal activities; to enhance cooperation among federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies through equitable sharing of assets recovered through the program; and to procure revenues to enhance forfeitures and strengthen law enforcement.

Through an agreement with the United States Department of Justice and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), the Office of District Attorney General of the Thirtieth Judicial District is participating in this forfeiture program. Under this agreement, the District Attorney General's Office has assigned to the Drug Task Force (DTF) an officer who is under the direct supervision and control of DEA supervisory personnel. Upon request by the District Attorney General's Office, DEA reimburses for overtime payments made to the officer assigned to the DTF. The District Attorney General's Office deposits these reimbursements with the Shelby County financial director, who channels the funds through Shelby County's General Fund. Also, under this agreement, the District Attorney General's Office requests from DEA its share of property recovered through joint law enforcement activities in which the officer assigned to the DTF participates. Payments received are deposited with the Shelby County Trustee's Office into the U.S. District Attorney General Federal Asset Forfeiture Fund. Pursuant to Department of Justice policy, funds made available through this program must be used by the District Attorney General's Office for law enforcement purposes.

Through an agreement with the Internal Revenue Service, the Office of District Attorney General of the Twentieth Judicial District is also participating in the forfeiture program. Payments received by the Twentieth Judicial District are deposited to a separate fund in Metro-Nashville Davidson County and must be used for law enforcement purposes.

DUI Task Force Fund

The DUI Task Force Fund consists of DUI district fines received by the Twenty-First Judicial District. This fund was closed during the year.

Metro/County Appropriations Fund

The Metro/County Appropriations Fund consists of funds appropriated by the counties and cities in the Twentieth and Twenty-Third Judicial Districts.

Mediation Services Fund

The Mediation Services Fund consists of funds received from a one dollar litigation tax that is assessed on all cases in the General Sessions and Juvenile Courts in Davidson County and other appropriations received by the Twentieth Judicial District for the support and operation of victim-offender mediation centers.

Methamphetamine Task Force Fund

The Methamphetamine Task Force Fund consists of grant funds passed-through Tennessee Technological University and other grant income received by the Thirteenth Judicial District.

Other Funds

Other funds in the Eighth Judicial District consist of a Community Prosecution and Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant passed through the City of Knoxville. Other funds in the Tenth Judicial District consist of funding from a Community Prosecution and Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant received from the U.S. Department of Justice. Other funds in the Thirtieth Judicial District consist of funds raised from contributions from the City of Memphis to enhance a witness protection program (Witness Relocation Fund), donations received from various groups to promote initiatives to increase the quality of life in certain communities located in Shelby County (Broken Window Fund), and certain forfeited funds (White Collar Crime Fund).

BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The various governmental funds are accounted for using the modified accrual basis of accounting.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

Total revenues and expenditures of these funds for the 31 judicial districts, as well as beginning and ending balances for the year examined, are presented on the following page:

SCOPE

The reviews include an examination of funds administered by the district attorneys general for the year ended June 30, 2007. In addition, the reviews include an examination of the administration of judicial district drug task force funds by the Drug Task Forces' Boards of Directors for the year ended June 30, 2007. Our reviews consisted of tests of records and auditing procedures that we considered necessary in the circumstances.

Findings and recommendations, as a result of our reviews, are presented in the Findings, Recommendations, and Financial Section of this report. Eleven judicial districts had material findings. We reviewed these findings and recommendations with the district attorneys general and representatives of the Drug Task Forces to provide an opportunity for their response. The written response from the District Attorney General of the Twenty-First Judicial District is included in this report. Other officials made oral responses; however, these oral responses have not been included in this report.

FINDING 07.01 THE DRUG TASK FORCE FUND HAD A CASH SHORTAGE OF \$1,244 ON JUNE 30, 2007

As noted in the prior year report, on October 10, 2006, the Drug Task Force director dismissed an agent for misappropriation of confidential investigative funds of the Judicial District Drug Task Force. The director contacted the Fourth Judicial District Attorney General's Office, and the case was referred to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI). On October 13, 2006, the dismissed agent, through his attorney remitted \$4,460 to the director to restore funds acknowledged to have been taken by the former agent. Our examination determined that the actual cash shortage was \$5,704 on October 10, 2006, leaving a balance of \$1,244 which had not been liquidated as of June 30, 2007. The TBI investigation resulted in the former agent being indicted on February 20, 2007, on two counts of theft over \$1,000. This case has not yet been tried.

RECOMMENDATION

Officials should seek restitution of the remaining cash shortage of \$1,244.

FINDING 07.01 DEFICIENCIES WERE NOTED IN THE CONTROL AND USE OF CELLULAR PHONES

Our examination revealed the following deficiencies in the control and use of cellular telephones paid for with the District Attorney's Fraud and Economic Crimes funds:

- A. The office made cellular telephones available for employees to use for business purposes. However, the office had not adopted written guidelines governing the use of these telephones.
- B. During the year examined, the office paid a total of \$5,850 for the use of these cellular telephones. Of this amount, \$2,344 was paid for exceeding the allowable monthly minutes, 411 connection fees, monthly text messaging charges, downloads, and other related extra charges.

RECOMMENDATION

The office should adopt written guidelines governing the use of cellular telephones. These guidelines should identify those who are entitled to use the telephones and the purposes for which the telephones can be used.

FINDING 07.02 SEVERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES DID NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE DRUG TASK FORCE

During the year, the City of Dunlap was the only agency that contributed to the operations of the Drug Task Force (DTF). The Twelfth Judicial District DTF was established in 1988 by an interlocal agreement among 27 law enforcement agencies within the district. This agreement provided that each agency would support the efforts of the drug task force with financial, equipment, and/or manpower contributions.

RECOMMENDATION

The law enforcement agencies within the judicial district should review their participation in the DTF, and agencies that do not wish to participate should withdraw from the interlocal agreement.

FINDING 07.03 THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS DID NOT ASSUME SUFFICIENT OVERSIGHT RESPONSIBILITY

The Board of Directors of the Drug Task Force (DTF) did not assume sufficient oversight responsibility for the DTF's operations. During the year examined, the board met twice, in August and September 2006. Another meeting was scheduled for May 2007, but was cancelled because a quorum was not present. Two meetings were not sufficient to review and approve all the task force's operations.

RECOMMENDATION

The board should meet regularly to approve and review the DTF's operations, including expenditures, personnel policies, controls over evidence and confiscations, and the status of cases. Minutes of these meeting should be documented and filed with the District Attorney General's Office.

THIRTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

FINDING 07.01 PURCHASE ORDERS WERE NOT ALWAYS ISSUED

The Putnam County Executive's Office administers purchasing for the Judicial District Drug Task Force Fund under purchasing procedures adopted by the Putnam County Commission. These purchasing procedures require the issuance of purchase orders; however, the County Executive's Office did not issue purchase orders for some applicable task force purchases. Purchase orders are necessary to control who has purchasing authority for the Judicial District Drug Task Force and to document purchasing commitments.

RECOMMENDATION

The Putnam County Executive's Office should issue purchase orders for all applicable Judicial District Drug Task Force purchases as required by Putnam County's purchasing procedures.

FINDING 07.02 INVENTORY RECORDS WERE NOT VERIFIED BY PERSONNEL INDEPENDENT OF MAINTAINING THE RECORDS

In prior years, the Drug Task Force (DTF) purchased several laptop computers through funds provided by methamphetamine grants. These computers were assigned to officers at the various law enforcement agencies throughout the district who attended methamphetamine training provided by the DTF. Each officer acknowledged receipt of the computer, and the computers are listed on the DTF equipment inventory. However, the DTF has not required the officers to account for the laptops since they were assigned to the officers.

RECOMMENDATION

Personnel independent of maintaining the inventory should periodically verify the inventory listing.

FINDING 07.03 DEFICIENCIES WERE NOTED IN THE MIDDLE TENNESSEE METHAMPHETAMINE TASK FORCE'S PURCHASING PROCEDURES

The Putnam County Executive's Office administers purchasing for the Middle Tennessee Methamphetamine Task Force Fund under purchasing procedures adopted by the Putnam County Commission. Our examination revealed the following purchasing deficiencies:

A. The Putnam County Executive's Office did not issue purchase orders for several applicable purchases. Purchase orders are necessary to control who

- has purchasing authority for the Methamphetamine Task Force and to document purchasing commitments.
- B. Competitive bids were not solicited for the design and printing of 125,000 methamphetamine drug education handbooks at a cost of \$55,000 and for the purchase of computers and accessories (\$13,586). Purchasing procedures for the Putnam County Executive's Office are governed by provisions of Chapter 63, Private Acts of 1981, which requires all purchases exceeding \$5,000 to be made on the basis of competitive bids solicited through advertisement in a local paper.

RECOMMENDATION

Purchase orders should be issued for all applicable purchases, and all purchases exceeding \$5,000 should be competitively bid as required by Putnam County's private act.

FINDING 07.04 CERTAIN TRANSACTIONS OF THE MIDDLE TENNESSEE METHAMPHETAMINE TASK FORCE WERE NOT CHANNELED THROUGH THE COUNTY TRUSTEE'S OFFICE

Putnam County accounts for transactions of the Methamphetamine Initiative Grant in the Other Agency Fund, an agency fund on deposit with the county trustee; however, the Middle Tennessee Methamphetamine Task Force (MTMTF) maintained a checking account for the proceeds from the sale of methamphetamine informational toolkits. Disbursements of \$16,436 were made from this checking account for equipment and travel. The following deficiencies were noted:

- A. Some funds administered by the MTMTF were not channeled through the county trustee's office. Procedures established for the MTMTF provide for nonconfidential expenses to be paid by warrant drawn on the county trustee from the Other Agency Fund.
- B. Transactions related to the sale of the methamphetamine information toolkits were not recorded in the accounting records of the Other Agency Fund. Therefore, bank statements were not reconciled with a general ledger. The bank balance was determined by confirmation and alternative auditing procedures.
- C. Collections from the sale of the methamphetamine information toolkits were not deposited to the office bank account within three days of collection. Section 5-8-207, <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>, requires all funds to be deposited within three days of collection.

RECOMMENDATION

The checking account should be closed, and the balance should be deposited with the county trustee in the Other Agency Fund. To strengthen internal controls over cash collections and deposits, the MTMTF should deposit all funds intact within three days of collection.

FINDING 07.05

AN EMPLOYEE USED PERSONAL FUNDS TO PURCHASE ITEMS FOR THE MIDDLE TENNESSEE METHAMPHETAMINE TASK FORCE

An employee of the Middle Tennessee Methamphetamine Task Force (MTMTF) used personal funds totaling \$19,619 to purchase items for the MTMTF. This employee was subsequently reimbursed by warrants drawn on the Other Agency Fund administered by the Putnam County Executive's Office (\$5,176) and by checks drawn on the MTMTF bank account (\$14,443). These purchases included computers and accessories, freight charges, business cards, booth rental, office equipment, warehouse rental, and electricity for the warehouse. We reviewed documentation for these purchases and determined that the expenditures were for the use and benefit of the MTMTF.

RECOMMENDATION

Employees should not use personal funds for business purposes. The Putnam County Executive's Office should administer purchasing for the MTMTF under purchasing procedures adopted by the Putnam County Commission.

FINDING 07.06 THE METHAMPHETAMINE TASK FORCE DID NOT MONITOR SUBRECIPIENTS OF FEDERAL AWARDS

The Middle Tennessee Methamphetamine Task Force (MTMTF) disbursed grant funds to the two subrecipients without monitoring the use of the funds. The approved budget for the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Methamphetamine Grant included a pass-through amount of \$35,000 for the Upper Cumberland Community Services Agency and \$5,000 for the Middle Tennessee Court Appointed State Advocacy, grant subrecipients. The MTMTF did not monitor the subrecipients' use of these federal funds to ensure that the awards were for authorized purposes in compliance with laws, regulations, and provisions of contracts or grant agreements as required by OMB Circular A-133.

RECOMMENDATION

The Middle Tennessee Methamphetamine Task Force should monitor subrecipients to ensure the federal awards were used for authorized purposes as required by federal grant regulations.

FINDING 07.01 AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE FALSIFIED TRAVEL CLAIMS TOTALING \$3,928

On July 13, 2007, the Office of District Attorney General notified us that their office had requested the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) to initiate an investigation of a suspected theft of district attorney general funds, which are maintained in the Williamson County Trustee's Office. The TBI examined travel reimbursement documentation on file for the District Attorney General's Office for the period February 2007 through July 2007, and determined that an employee of the District Attorney General's Office had submitted to the Williamson County Trustee's Office 18 fraudulent travel claims and/or letters requesting reimbursement. Irregularities noted include: (1) the signature of the district attorney general or other authorizing agent in the office had been forged on the travel claims and/or reimbursement letters, (2) the fraudulent travel claims and/or reimbursement letters had not been submitted to the District Attorney General's Office for supervisory review, (3) personnel in the Williamson County Trustee's advised that on several occasions checks were issued to this employee prior to documentation being filed, and (4) the travel claims reflected requests for reimbursements for the same day on 37 separate occasions. Due to these fraudulent travel claims and/or reimbursement letters, the financial statements of this report reflect a cash shortage of \$3,438 in the District Attorney General Fund on June 30, 2007. Fraudulent travel claims and letters requesting reimbursement in July 2007 totaled \$490, bringing the total cash shortage to \$3,928. On July 17, 2007, the employee admitted to falsifying travel claims and letters requesting reimbursement, and his employment was terminated. During October 2007, the employee pled guilty to one charge of theft of property under \$500 and one charge of falsifying government records. The employee also paid a reduced amount of restitution totaling \$3,630.

RECOMMENDATION

Internal controls should be strengthened to ensure that all travel claims and/or letters requesting reimbursement have been properly approved by management and that adequate payment authorization is presented to the county trustee prior to payment.

MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSE – DISTRICT ATTORNEY GENERAL

A special prosecutor has prosecuted the individual responsible. He has been convicted, paid restitution, and will have a criminal record. New accounting controls regarding travel claims have been set in place.

Forms documenting payments to confidential informants require the signatures of two officers. The first officer signs that he made the payment, and the second officer signs that he witnessed the payment. Forms maintained in the Drug Task Force office for payments to confidential informants did not always reflect the signature of a second officer witnessing the payment. All signatures on this form are necessary to document payments to confidential informants.

RECOMMENDATION

All forms required to document drug control transactions should be completed properly and should be reviewed for accuracy by supervisory personnel.

RECOMMENDATION

The board should meet regularly to approve and review the DTF's operations, including expenditures, personnel policies, controls over evidence and confiscations, and the status of cases. Minutes of these meetings should be on file for inspection.
