The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire, in and for the body of the County of Humphreys, in the State aforesaid, upon their oaths, present: That LANCE LOVELESS heretofore, to-wit: between August 11, 2011 and April 1, 2015, and prior to the finding of this Presentment, in the County of Humphreys aforesaid, then and there, being a public servant with the intent to obtain a benefit, did unlawfully, feloniously, intentionally or knowingly commit an act relating his office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power; committed an act under color of office or employment that exceeds his official power, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, a Class E Felony, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO:

And the Grand Jurors, aforesaid, upon their oaths, aforesaid, do further present and say, that between August 11, 2011 and April 1, 2015, and prior to the finding of this Presentment, in the County and State aforesaid, the said LANCE LOVELESS then and there, being a public servant with the intent to obtain a benefit, did unlawfully, intentionally or knowingly receive a benefit not otherwise authorized by law, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, a Class A Misdemeanor, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT THREE:

And the Grand Jurors, aforesaid, upon their oaths, aforesaid, do further present and say, that between August 11, 2011 and April 1, 2015, and prior to the finding of this Presentment, in the County and State aforesaid, the said LANCE LOVELESS then and there, did unlawfully, knowingly and feloniously obtain or exercise control over property, to-wit: Five Thousand Six Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$5,617.00) in benefits for

accident and cancer insurance coverage, a further description to the Grand Jurors aforesaid unknown, over the value of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) but less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), of City of New Johnsonville, without their effective consent, with the intent to deprive said City of New Johnsonville, thereof, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, a Class D Felony, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
