WALKER** on or about 07/01/04 through 12/28/06, in McNairy County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly exercise control over property to-wit: U.S. Currency, a more particular description thereof being to the Grand Jurors unknown, valued at over one thousand dollars (\$1,000) but less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), of City of Adamsville, without its effective consent, with the intent to deprive said City of Adamsville thereof, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO


And the Grand Jurors on their oath aforesaid further present that in McNairy County on or about 07/01/04 through 12/28/06, before the finding of this indictment, the said **LINDA H. WALKER** did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly, while a public servant, to-wit: Adamsville City Court Clerk, with intent to obtain a benefit, did receive a benefit, to-wit: U.S. Currency, not otherwise authorized by law, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.





