POST TRIAL DIVERSION - PROBATION ORDER

The defendant, Carol Sue Mason, is charged in indictment 268613 with the offense of Theft of Property, a class "C" felony.

She has waived her right to a trial by jury and entered a plea of guilty to Theft Over \$10,000, class "C" felony, as a range I offender.

She faces a sentence of three (3) year(s) in the Department of Correction.

Pursuant to TCA 40-35-313, and with defendant's consent, it is,


ORDERED that,

- 1) Entry of the judgment of guilty is withheld;
- 2) Sentencing and further proceedings are deferred; and
- 3) Defendant is placed on probation, subject to the conditions set out hereinafter.
- 4) Upon violation of a condition of probation, the Court will issue a capias for the defendant and will schedule a sentencing hearing.
- 5) If defendant does not violate any of the conditions of the probation, completes three (3) years of good behavior, and pays the court costs, the Court will dismiss the proceedings against the defendant and order the public records expunged.

CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

- 1) She will be on supervised probation for a period of three (3) years. Supervision will be by the State Probation Office and she will obey all rules and regulations of probation. She will pay \$10.00 per month as part payment of the expenses of supervision. **Supervised Probation to begin September 21, 2009.**
- 2) She will not commit any offenses under the laws of the State of Tennessee, the United States, or any other State.
- 3) She will refrain from possessing a firearm or other dangerous weapon.
- 4) She will conduct herself in a manner consistent with good citizenship. She will meet her family responsibilities.
- 5) She will not consume alcoholic beverages, and will not use any controlled substance, except as may be prescribed for medical condition.
- 6) She will not engage in any activities, conduct and associations, bearing a relationship to the conduct which the charge against her was based.
- 7) Restitution hearing set for September 21, 2009, at 9:00 A.M. to determine the amount of restitution and per month payment.
- 8) Payment of costs to be determined at Restitution hearing.
- 9) She will devote herself to a specific employment or occupation or pursue a prescribed secular course of study or vocational training.
