 Pursuant to 39-13-521 the defendant is ordered to provide a biological specimen for the purpose of HIV testing.

Special Conditions: Pursuant to 39-13-524 the defendant is sentenced to community supervision for life following sentence expiration.

ON RECOMMENDATION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THIS SENTENCE IS HEREBY SUSPENDED ON PAYMENT OF COSTS AND RESTITUTION AND THE DEFENDANT IS PLACED ON PROBATION UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE STATE PROBATION OFFICE, TO EXPIRE JULY 23, 2019. DEFENDANT'S PROBATION IS CONDITIONED UPON HER NOT HEREAFTER VIOLATING ANY OF THE LAWS OF ANY CITY, STATE OR OF THE UNITED STATES OR BEING GUILTY OF ANY MISCONDUCT INCONSISTENT WITH GOOD CITIZENSHIP. IT IS FURTHER CONDITIONED THAT THE DEFENDANT SHALL PAY THE COSTS IN THIS CAUSE: MAKE RESTITUTION TO THE VICTIM, ALONG WITH A 5% CLERK'S FEE, SAID PAYMENT TO BE PAID TO THE CLERK'S OFFICE UNTIL PAID IN FULL; AND THAT SHE SHALL ABIDE BY ANY AND ALL CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE PROBATION OFFICER. THE CLERK WILL FURNISH A COPY OF THIS JUDGMENT TO THE DEFENDANT, HER COUNSEL, AND THE STATE PROBATION OFFICER. ON RECOMMENDATION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL THE 2ND COUNT OF THIS INDICTMENT IS HEREBY DISMISSED. THIS CASE IS PLACED IN THE COST DOCKET.




The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, upon their oaths, present that ROBIN PRICE, ALIAS, heretofore, to-wit: On or about the ____ day of November, 2005, and on divers and diverse days between that date and the ____ day of September, 2007, in the State and County aforesaid, did unlawfully and knowingly obtain and exercise control over property, to-wit: a quantity of good and lawful money of the United States of America, the further kinds, types, descriptions and denominations thereof to the Grand Jurors unknown, of the value of at least Ten Thousand and 00/100 (\$10,000.00) Dollars but less than Sixty Thousand and 00/100 (\$60,000.00) Dollars, of East Tennessee Human Resource Agency without its effective consent, with intent to deprive the said East Tennessee Human Resource Agency thereof, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

SECOND COUNT:

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present that ROBIN PRICE, ALIAS, heretofore, to-wit: On or about the ____ day of November, 2005, and on divers and diverse days between that date and the ____ day of September, 2007, in the State and County aforesaid, did unlawfully and knowingly, and with intent to defraud and harm East Tennessee Human Resource Agency, forge writings, to-wit: endorsements on checks, of the value of at least Ten Thousand and 00/100 (\$10,000.00) Dollars but less than Sixty Thousand and 00/100 (\$60,000.00) Dollars and the said ROBIN PRICE, ALIAS, did make said writings so that said writings purported to be the act of of the person to whom the check was made out to who did not authorize said act, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-114, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
