In this cause it is ordered by the undersigned Judge that the defendant is hereby placed under the Supervision of Westate Probation Services, Inc. for a period of 12 mos and that the Defendant shall comply with the following orders:

- 1. Pay all court costs, fines, restitution, and supervision fees.
2. Not to violate any federal, state, county or city law.
3. Make full and truthful report to probation officer in person and/or in writing as directed.
4. Inform probation officer before changing residence, employment, or leaving the State of Tennessee.
5. Not to use intoxicants of any kind to excess, not use narcotic drugs, inhalants, or controlled substances, or enter any establishment where the sale of alcoholic beverages is the primary source of business.
6. Work at a lawful occupation and support dependants, if any, to the best of your ability.

The defendant shall comply with the following specific conditions if directed by the Court.

B. Not to maintain any checking account or charge account.
C. Attend GED classes or Literacy counseling.
D. Attend in/out-patient program for alcohol/drug rehabilitation.

F. Complete 40 hours community service work.
G. Attend A) DUI School B) Anger Management C) Personal Responsibility Class
H. Not to go around, about, contact, or have contacted in any way
