COUNT 1

THE GRAND JURORS of Davidson County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

PATRICIA A. ANDERSON


on divers days from the **13th** day of **February, 2006**, through the **5th** day of **January, 2009**, in Davidson County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, knowingly did obtain or exercise control over certain property, to wit: **money**, of the value of **\$10,000 or more but less than \$60,000**, the property of **the City of Lakewood**, without the effective consent of **the City of Lakewood**, with the intent to deprive **the City of Lakewood** of the property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 2

THE GRAND JURORS of Davidson County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

PATRICIA A. ANDERSON

on divers days from the 13th day of February, 2006, through the 5th day of January, 2009, in Davidson County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, did intentionally or knowingly forge writings described or depicted as follows: **business records of the City of Lakewood** of the value of **\$10,000 or more but less than \$60,000**, with the intent to defraud or harm another, to wit: **the City of Lakewood**, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-14-114, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
