THE GRAND JURORS of Fayette County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that **JULIE LYNNE FULLER AKA JULIE COLE** on various dates between August 7, 2006 and July 5, 2007, pursuant to a common scheme or plan in Fayette County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly obtain property, to-wit: lawful U.S. currency, a more particular description thereof being to the Grand Jurors unknown, valued at over ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) but less than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), of City of Oakland without their effective consent, with the intent to deprive said City of Oakland thereof, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-104, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO

And the Grand Jurors on their oath aforesaid further present that in Fayette County on various dates between August 7, 2006 and July 5, 2007, pursuant to a common scheme or plan, before the finding of this indictment, the said **JULIE LYNNE FULLER AKA JULIE COLE** did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly, while a public servant, i.e. Accounts Payable Clerk, with intent to obtain a benefit, did receive a benefit i.e. lawful U.S. currency, not otherwise authorized by law, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
