THE GRAND JURORS of Fayette County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that **SHERRILL MASON** on various dates between October 17, 2006 and March 9, 2007, pursuant to a common scheme or plan in Fayette County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly obtain property to-wit: lawful U.S. currency, a more particular description thereof being to the Grand Jurors unknown, valued at over one thousand dollars (\$1,000) but less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), of Town Of Somerville without their effective consent, with the intent to deprive said Town Of Somerville thereof, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO

And the Grand Jurors on their oath aforesaid further present that in Fayette County on various dates between October 17, 2006 and March 9, 2007, before the finding of this indictment, the said **SHERRILL MASON** did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly, while a public servant, i.e. Town of Somerville City Court Clerk, with intent to obtain a benefit, did receive a benefit i.e. lawful U.S. currency, not otherwise authorized by law, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.


