
ORDER FOR JUDICIAL DIVERSION PURSUANT TO T.C.A. 40-35-313

This cause came to be heard on the 12th day of May, 2004, by agreement between the defendant, Melissa Woodlee, and the State of Tennessee, by and through the District Attorney General upon a plea of guilty to Theft of Property \$10,000 - \$60,000 in violation of T.C.A. §39-14-103. Upon a showing that the defendant is eligible for such action, pursuant to T.C.A. §40-35-313.

It is hereby **ORDERED** that the defendant's plea of guilty to the offense of Theft of Property \$10,000 - \$60,000, T.C.A. §39-14-103, is accepted but the entry of a judgment of guilty to that offense is hereby deferred for a period of four (4) years from the date of the entry of this order conditioned upon the Defendant paying court costs, \$75.00 to the Economic Crime Fund and restitution in the amount of \$36,503.46 (includes \$2,000 for audit costs) directly to West Warren Viola Utility District on the day of plea and having no criminal convictions for conduct occurring during the period of diversion.

Should the Defendant fail to abide by the terms of this order, a Judgment shall be entered against her finding her guilty of Theft of Property \$10,000 - \$60,000 in violation on T.C.A. §39-14-103 and requiring that she serve a penitentiary sentence of four (4) years as a Range I Standard Offender.

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PLEA OF GUILTY AND WAIVERS OF JURY TRIAL AND OF APPEAL

I have received and read a copy of the indictment and discussed it with my attorney. My attorney has informed me as to the nature of the charges against me and I understand the nature of the charges. My attorney has further advised me as to the minimum and maximum possible punishment for the crime or crimes. **I desire to voluntarily enter a plea of GUILTY.**

I am pleading guilty to the offense or offenses listed below. I understand that I could continue with a not guilty plea to any offense charged and that I have a right to a speedy and public trial by jury. I understand I have the right to be represented by an attorney in all stages of the proceedings against me and if I cannot afford an attorney, an appointed attorney would represent me without any cost to me. I understand that if I went to trial I or my attorney would have the right to question and cross-examine any witnesses that testified against me, that I could subpoena witnesses to testify for me and that I could not be forced to testify at trial and incriminate myself. I also understand I have the right to have a jury impose any fine in excess of \$50.00. I understand that by pleading guilty I give up or waive my right to a jury trial and all the above rights. I also understand that I am giving up my right to an appeal on all matters except those to be decided by the Court.

By pleading guilty I understand that my plea will be considered as a guilty plea, and I further understand that I may be questioned regarding the offense or offenses and that I can be punished for perjury if I give false answers under oath. I understand that any prior convictions I have may be

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considered by the Court in sentencing. I am waiving my right to file all post conviction proceedings and to habeas corpus relief that may be filed under the Tennessee Statutes.

I understand that the conviction or convictions today may be used in a future proceeding to make my punishment greater should I be sentenced in the future for another offense.

I am pleading guilty of my own free will and choice. No force has been exerted on me nor have any threats been made against me to get me to plead guilty. No promises have been made to me other than the details of my guilty plea set forth on this form. I am aware of the action I am taking and request the Court to accept my guilty plea. I waive my right to jury trial and appeal and submit **MY** case to the trial judge for full and final determination. I understand that I can no longer vote pursuant to statute until I have my rights restored by the Court.

I AM CHARGED WITH THE FOLLOWING OFFENSE (S):

OFFENSE: **Theft of Property \$10,000 - \$60,0000, a class "C" Felony(T.C.A. §39-14-103)**

POSSIBLE PUNISHMENT: **3 - 15 years. Maximum fine is \$10,000.**
