## **Tipton County Receives Clean Audit Report**

The Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury is recognizing a significant achievement by Tipton County government leaders and elected officials.

The Tipton County audit for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 contains no findings. This is a testament to Tipton County's commitment to a strong system of internal controls, which are the checks and balances put in place to help government achieve its objectives and reduce risk.

"Tipton County leaders and its citizens can be proud of this exemplary audit report," said Comptroller Justin P. Wilson. "By reducing risk, establishing strong policies, and following best practices, Tipton County can now claim to have one of the strongest systems of county government in the state."

The Tennessee Comptroller's Office audits 89 of Tennessee's 95 counties. Last year only two of the 89 counties (Hamblen and Robertson) received clean audit reports. Tipton County's 2014 audit report contained only one finding, which has now been corrected.

Tipton County's audit is the first FY 2015 report released by the Comptroller's Office that contains no audit findings.
