Butterworth Elected President of Board of Directors of National Council of State Housing Agencies

Ann Butterworth has been elected as President of the 2009 -10 Board of Directors of the National Council of State Housing Boards (NCSHB), announced Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury Justin P. Wilson.

Butterworth is assistant to the Comptroller for public finance and has worked for the Comptroller's Office since 1987. She has a law degree from Vanderbilt University and a Bachelor of Arts degree from Duke University.

The NCSHB exists to provide educational and training opportunities for state housing finance agency (HFA) board members to help them govern their agencies most effectively.

The NCSHB Board of Directors, comprised of HFA board members from across the country, directs NCSHB. The board meets three times a year—during NCSHA's Legislative Conference in the spring, at the NCSHB Educational and Development Workshop in late summer and during NCSHA's Annual Conference & Tradeshow in the fall. The board also convenes bi-monthly via conference call.
