The Grand Jurors of Franklin County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn upon their oath, present that:

Jeffrey Jerome Frame and James Wesley Parks between December 31, 2011 and September 1, 2014 in Franklin County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, knowingly obtain control of or exercise control over **good and lawful U.S. currency**, being the personal goods and property of **City of Decherd**, without the owner's effective consent and with the intent to deprive the true owner thereof, the value of said personal goods and property being at least \$60,000.00 but less than \$250,000.00; in violation of **T.C.A. 39-14-103**, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
