FIRST COUNT:

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of HARDIN, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That AMBER RENEE TERRY heretofore, to-wit: DURING A PERIOD BETWEEN MARCH, 2012 AND AUGUST, 2012 before the finding of this indictment, in the County aforesaid, then and there did intentionally or knowingly obtain or exercise control over property, to-wit: MONEY of the value MORE THAN TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO/100 (\$10,000.00) BUT LESS THAN SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO/100 (\$60,000.00) being the property of THE HARDIN COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE without the owner's effective consent, with the intent to deprive the said HARDIN COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE thereof, thereby committing the offense of THEFT OF PROPERTY, in violation of TCA §39-14-103, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.





SECOND COUNT:

The Grand Jurors of the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of HARDIN, in the State aforesaid, upon their oath present:

That AMBER RENEE TERRY, a public servant employed as a Deputy Clerk by the HARDIN COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE, heretofore, to-wit: DURING A PERIOD OF TIME BETWEEN MARCH, 2012 AND AUGUST, 2012, before the finding of this indictment in the County aforesaid, then and there did knowingly or intentionally with intent to obtain a benefit, violate a law relating to the said AMBER RENEE TERRY'S employment by committing THEFT OF PROPERTY, being MONEY belonging to the HARDIN COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE, and did knowingly or intentionally obtain or exercise control over said cash with the consent of the HARDIN COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE, thereby committing the offense of OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402 (a) (4), against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.


