


IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR LAWRENCE COUNTY, TENNESSEE

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire, in and for the body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, upon their oath present: Adam Brewer, on or about September 16, 2016, in his capacity as a public servant, an employee of the Lawrence County Sheriff's Office, and prior to the finding of this presentment, did unlawfully and with intent, use property of Lawrence County, an assigned vehicle, for personal benefit in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402 a Class E felony. Adam Brewer traveled to the State of Florida for a personal vacation in the assigned vehicle. Adam Brewer purchased fuel with a county fuel card, prior to departure, in the amount of \$33.93 (thirty three dollars and ninety three cents), all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire, in and for the body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, upon their oath present: **Jimmy R. Brown**, Sheriff of Lawrence County, on or about May 1, 2016 through July 24, 2017 and prior to the finding of this presentment, did unlawfully, while having supervision and control over an inmate of the Tennessee Department of Corrections, Michael Smith, did allow the inmate to be used to work on private property in violation of T.C.A. 4-6-138 a class E felony, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO:

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire, in and for the body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, upon their oath present: **Jimmy R. Brown**, Sheriff of Lawrence County, on or about May 1, 2016 through July 24, 2017 did unlawfully and with intent to obtain a benefit, and prior to the finding of this presentment, commit the offense of Official Misconduct, T.C.A. 39-16-402, a class E felony. **Jimmy R. Brown**, a public servant, violated T.C.A. 4-6-138 prohibiting the use of inmate labor by a department of corrections inmate and received a benefit not authorized by law. **Jimmy R. Brown** received the benefit of inmate labor at his personal residence and allowed the use of inmate labor at the private residences of individuals employed by the Lawrence County Sheriff's Office, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT THREE:

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire, in and for the body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, upon their oath present: **Jimmy R. Brown**, Sheriff of Lawrence County, between the dates of June 9, 2016 and February 5, 2018, and prior to the finding of this presentment, did unlawfully, while knowing that an investigation was pending or in progress, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-503, a class C felony, destroy evidence to wit: illegal liquor "moonshine" collected as evidence in an investigation on June 9, 2016 by the Lawrence County Sheriff's Office, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT FOUR:

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire, in and for the body of Lawrence County, Tennessee, upon their oath present: **Jimmy R. Brown**, Sheriff of Lawrence County, on or about May 1, 2016 through May 1, 2018 did unlawfully and with intent to obtain a benefit, and prior to the finding of this presentment, commit the offense of Official Misconduct, T.C.A. 39-16-402, a class E felony. **Jimmy R. Brown**, a public servant, grant unauthorized furloughs for county inmates, allowed unauthorized recognizance bonds without authorization from a judicial official, failed to certify the securities of sureties, released a charged defendant prior to the mandatory five hour holding period on a Driving Under the Influence arrest and allowed inmates to be released from the jail without supervision, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
