COUNT 1

The Grand Jurors of Coffee County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **Alyce Faith Heifner** on or about the time frame of July, 2014, through October, 2015, in Coffee County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly did obtain or exercise control over the property of the Manchester- Coffee County Conference Center, the said property being money and being of the value of more than \$10,000.00 dollars, with the intent to deprive the true owner thereof and without the owner's effective consent, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 2

The Grand Jurors of Coffee County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **Alyce Faith Heifner** on or about the time frame of July, 2014, through October, 2015, in Coffee County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, unlawfully, knowingly and feloniously did commit an offense, while being a public servant, said **Alyce Faith Heifner** being An employee for Coffee County, TN, said offense committed with intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, by committing an act relating to the public servant's office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 3

The Grand Jurors of Coffee County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **Alyce Faith Heifner** on or about the time frame of July, 2014, through October, 2015, in Coffee County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, unlawfully, knowingly and feloniously did commit an offense, while being a public servant, said **Alyce Faith Heifner** being An employee for Coffee County, TN, said offense committed with intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, by committing an act under color of office or employment that exceeds the public servant's official power, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402(a)(2) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
