CHARGE: THEFT OVER \$10,000

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, upon their oaths, present that **LORI BETH FEASTER**, between the 10th day of June, 2010 and the 31st day of January 2011, and before the finding of this Indictment, pursuant to a continuous larcenous scheme and while concealing the detection thereof, did knowingly obtain or exercise control over property to-wit: cash and checks of a value of \$10,000 (Ten Thousand Dollars) or more, belonging to the North Elizabethton Water Division, without the effective consent of the North Elizabethton Water Division and with the intent to deprive the North Elizabethton Water Division of the property, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, a class C felony, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT TWO:

CHARGE: THEFT OVER \$10,000

And these same Grand Jurors upon their same oath further present that **LORI BETH FEASTER**, between the 1st day of May, 2011 and the 31st day of January 2012, and before the finding of this Indictment, pursuant to a continuous larcenous scheme and while concealing the detection thereof, did knowingly obtain or exercise control over property to-wit: checks of a value of \$10,000 (Ten Thousand Dollars) or more, belonging to the Watauga River Regional Water Authority, without the effective consent of the Watauga River Regional Water Authority, and with the intent to deprive the Watauga River Regional Water Authority of the property, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, a class C felony, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT THREE:

CHARGE: FRAUDULENT USE OF A CREDIT CARD

And these same Grand Jurors upon their same oath further present that **LORI BETH FEASTER**, between the 1st day of March, 2011 and the 31st day of August 2011, and before the finding of this Indictment, pursuant to a continuous larcenous scheme and while concealing the detection thereof, did knowingly use a Lowe's credit card belonging to the Watauga River Regional Water Authority for the purpose of obtaining property or other things of value worth \$1,000 (One Thousand Dollars) or more with knowledge that she was not authorized to make personal purchases with said card, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-118, a class D felony, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT FOUR:

CHARGE: OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT

And these same Grand Jurors upon their same oath further present that **LORI BETH FEASTER**, between the 1st day of June 2010 and the 31st day of January 2012, and before the finding of this Indictment, pursuant to a continuous larcenous scheme and while concealing the detection thereof, with intent to obtain a benefit or harm another, did intentionally or knowingly violate a law relating to her employment, to-wit: Theft of Property from the North Elizabethton Water Division, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, a class E felony, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT FIVE:

CHARGE: OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT

And these same Grand Jurors upon their same oath further present that **LORI BETH FEASTER** between the 1st day of May 2011 and the 31st day of January 2012, and before the finding of this Indictment, pursuant to a continuous larcenous scheme and while concealing the detection thereof, with intent to obtain a benefit or harm another, did intentionally or knowingly violate a law relating to her employment, to-wit: Theft of Property from the Watauga River Regional Water Authority, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, a class E felony, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT SIX:

CHARGE: FORGERY

And these same Grand Jurors upon their same oath further present that **LORI BETH FEASTER**, between the 1st day of May 2011 and the 31st day of January 2012, and before the finding of this Indictment, pursuant to a continuous larcenous scheme and while concealing the detection thereof did unlawfully and knowingly make false entries into the books and records of the Watauga River Regional Water Authority with the intent to defraud or harm the Watauga River Regional Water Authority, all of which is a class E felony in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-114 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT SEVEN:

CHARGE: FORGERY

And these same Grand Jurors upon their same oath further present that **LORI BETH FEASTER**, between the 1st day of May 2011 and the 31st day of January 2012, and before the finding of this Indictment, pursuant to a continuous larcenous scheme and while concealing the detection thereof did unlawfully and knowingly make false entries into the books and records of the North Elizabethton Water Division with the intent to defraud or harm the North Elizabethton Water Division, all of which is a class E felony in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-114 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
