
THE GRAND JURORS of Tipton County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that **GLEND A BROWN**, between October 21, 2022 and November 04, 2022, in Tipton County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly, while employed by the Tipton County Emergency Communications District, and with the intent to obtain a benefit, commit an act relating to the servant's office or employment that constitutes an authorized exercise of official power, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 2

And the Grand Jurors on their oath aforesaid further present that in Tipton County on or about October 21, 2022, before the finding of this indictment, the said **GLEND A BROWN**, did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly obtain property to-wit: six thousand one hundred fifty dollars and fifty one cents (\$6,150.51) in unearned compensation, unauthorized annual leave, excess unearned salary compensation and employer paid matching payroll benefits for Medicare, Social Security, unemployment insurance, and Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System, a more particular description thereof being to the Grand Jurors unknown, valued at over two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) but less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), of Tipton County Communications without it's effective consent, with the intent to deprive said Tipton County Communications thereof, in violation of T.C.A. 39-14-103, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 3

And the Grand Jurors on their oath aforesaid further present that in Tipton County on or about June 22, 2021, before the finding of this indictment, the said **GLEND A BROWN**, did unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly, pursuant to a common scheme or plan, with the intent to deprive Tipton County Emergency Communications, **GLEND A BROWN** did knowingly make a false entry in or alter payroll compensatory leave usage records, in violation of T.C.A 39-16-504(a)(1), against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
