Special Conditions: Time served. Defendant is placed on Intensive State Probation. Must complete 200 hours of community service work, minimum 8 hours per month. Restitution to be paid in full on the date of entry of the plea. To pay \$100 per month beginning within 30 days of plea. Must have no contact with any victims or witnesses. Submit to random monthly drug and alcohol screens.
