The Grand Jurors of Lawrence County, Tennessee, duly impaneled, and sworn upon their oath, present: That BRADLEY LEE on, about or between August 17, 2022 and January 31, 2023, in Lawrence County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and knowingly obtain or exercise control over property, to-wit: monies in the amount of \$1134.56, of the value of more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) but less than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500), from Centerpoint Volunteer Fire Department, without their effective consent, with the intent to deprive the said Centerpoint Volunteer Fire Department thereof, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated Section 39-14-103, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.


