CHARGE: THEFT OF PROPERTY

COUNT 1

The Grand Jurors for the CRIMINAL COURT for HAWKINS COUNTY, TENNESSEE, meeting on August 11, 2025, in ROGERSVILLE, after being duly sworn upon their oath present that **PEGGY FAYE LONG** between **January 17, 2025 and March 18, 2025**, in the State and County aforesaid, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully commit the offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY OVER TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) BUT LESS THAN SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000)** by knowingly obtaining or exercising control over \$26,000 without the effective consent of the owner, the Lakeview Fire Department or its designee Chief Curtis Bean, and with the intent to deprive the Lakeview Fire Department thereof; a Class C felony, in violation of Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 39-14-103 and 105, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.





