THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **JULIE ANN ODOM** heretofore on or between the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2024 and the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2024 in Putnam County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment being a public servant as defined by Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-16-401, did unlawfully, knowingly, and with intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, committed an act relating to the public servant's office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power, to wit: Theft of property over the value of \$2,500 in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-103, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-16-402(a)(1), a Class E Felony, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

January Term of the Criminal Court of the said County, 2026

## Count 2:

THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **JULIE ANN ODOM** heretofore on or between the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2024 and the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2024 in Putnam County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment knowingly did obtain or exercise control over certain property, to wit: cash, of the value of than \$2,500 but less than \$10,000, the property of 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Recovery Court, without the effective consent of the 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Recovery Court, with the intent to deprive 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Recovery Court, of the property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-14-103, a Class D Felony, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

## Count 3:

THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **JULIE ANN ODOM** heretofore on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2024 in Putnam County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment being a public servant as defined by Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-16-401, did unlawfully, knowingly, and with intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, committed an act relating to the public servant's office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power, to wit: Criminal Simulation, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-115, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-16-402(a)(1), a Class E Felony, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

## Count 4:

THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **JULIE ANN ODOM** heretofore on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2024 in Putnam County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, intentionally did make or alter an object in whole or in part, to wit: Invoice, so that the object did appear to have a value of Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$925.00) because of authorship that it does not have, with intent to defraud or harm another, to wit: 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Recovery Court, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-14-115, a Class E Felony, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

## Count 5:

THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **JULIE ANN ODOM** heretofore on the 16th day of August, 2024 in Putnam County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment being a public servant as defined by Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-16-401, did unlawfully, knowingly, and with intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, committed an act relating to the public servant's office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power, to wit: Forgery, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-114, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-16-402(a)(1), a Class E Felony, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

## Count 6:

THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **JULIE ANN ODOM** heretofore on the 16th day of August, 2024 in Putnam County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, did intentionally or knowingly forge a writing described or depicted as follows: Lease Agreement of the value of Twenty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$26,400.00), with the intent to defraud or harm another, to wit: 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Recovery Court, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-14-114, a Class C Felony, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

## Count 7:

THE GRAND JURORS of Putnam County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn upon their oath present that **JULIE ANN ODOM** heretofore on the 16th day of August, 2024 in Putnam County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, did intentionally or knowingly forge a writing described or depicted as follows: Receipt of the value of Two Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,200.00), with the intent to defraud or harm another, to wit: 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Recovery Court, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-14-114, a Class C Felony, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
