THE GRAND JURORS of BEDFORD County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

LILIA PATINO TORRES

on divers days between JANUARY 1, 2023 and SEPTEMBER 8, 2025, in BEDFORD County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, knowingly did obtain or exercise control over certain property, to-wit: UNITED STATES CURRENCY, of the value of TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000) DOLLARS OR MORE BUT LESS THAN SIXTY THOUSAND (\$60,000) DOLLARS, the property of CITY OF SHELBYVILLE, without the effective consent of CITY OF SHELBYVILLE, with the intent to deprive CITY OF SHELBYVILLE of the property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

THE GRAND JURORS of BEDFORD County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

on divers days between JANUARY 1, 2023 and SEPTEMBER 8, 2025, in BEDFORD County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, while being a public servant, to-wit: SHELBYVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT CLERK, intentionally or knowingly with intent did violate a law relating to the public servant's office or employment with intent to obtain a benefit or harm another, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-16-402 and the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

THE GRAND JURORS of BEDFORD County, Tennessee, duly impaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that:

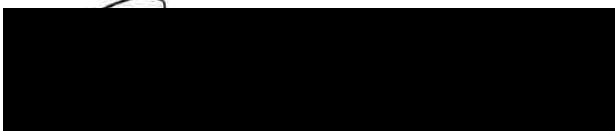
LILIA PATINO TORRES
