COUNT 1

The Grand Jurors for the State of Tennessee, duly elected, impaneled, sworn, and charged to inquire in and for the body of the County of Fentress, in the State of Tennessee, upon their oath, present: That

LESLIE PULLINS

prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about January 2010 - May 2013, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously, knowingly and without the effective consent of the owner, obtain cash and other funds, the property of the Fentress County Library and Fentress County government, with the intent to deprive the said owner of the property, valued at more than \$10,000, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 2

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present: That **LESLIE PULLINS** prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about May 2013, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously, knowingly and without the effective consent of the owner, obtain cash, the property of the Fentress County Historical Society, with the intent to deprive the said owner of the property, valued at more than \$500, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 3

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present: That **LESLIE PULLINS** prior to the finding of this indictment, on or about January 2010 - May 2013, in the County and State aforesaid, did unlawfully, feloniously and intentionally and knowingly as a public service, the director for the Fentress County Library, violate a law relating to her office and employment with the intent to obtain a benefit, against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.




